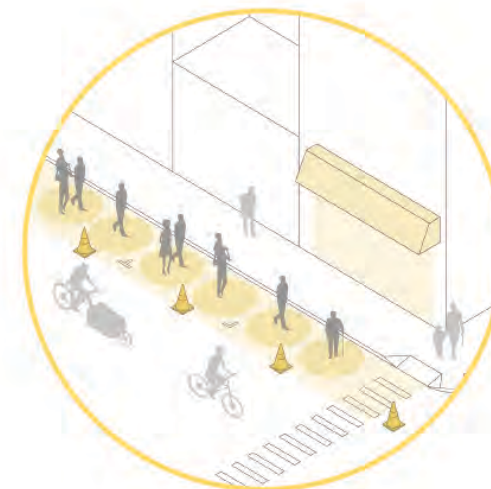

3. Shape business districts as destinations for safe and healthy activities.

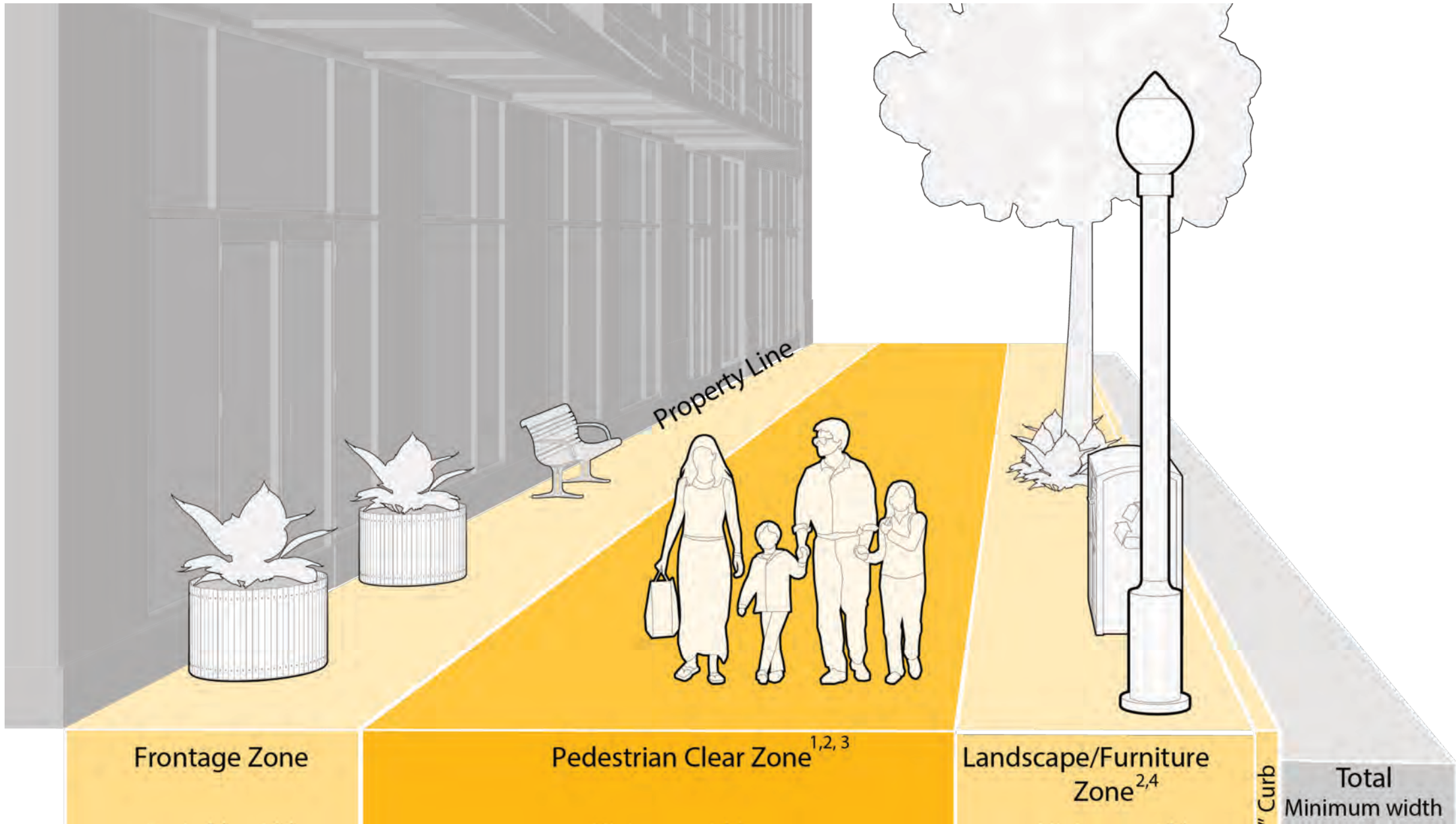
Principles

4. Protect now and iterate over time to build lasting recovery.

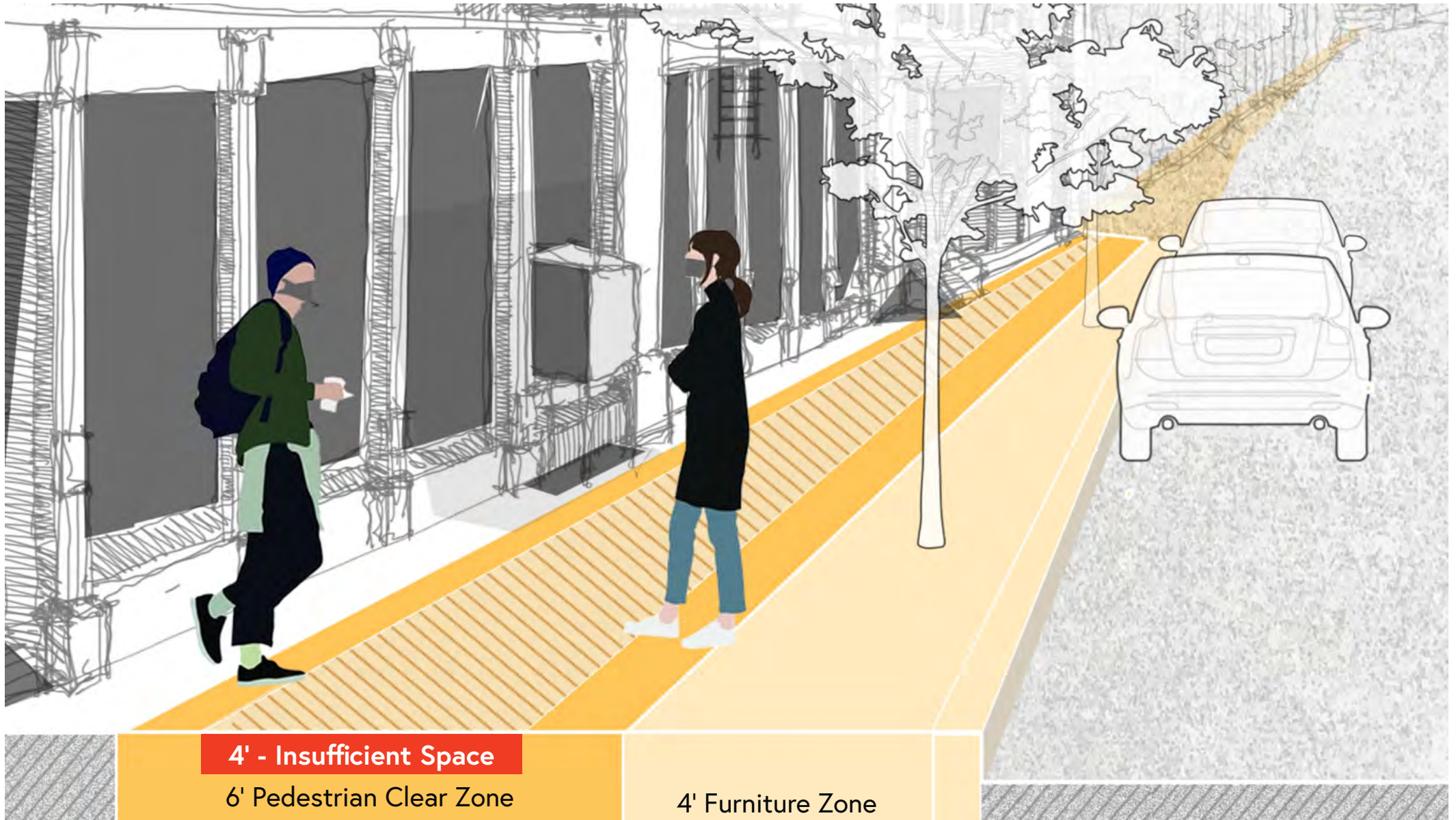
Collaborative Development Steps
