Welcome and Introductions

Peter Heffernan, Chair, welcomed everyone at 10:00 a.m. and then took a roll call and confirmed the members and alternates present.

Approval of Meeting Summary

The summary for the September 22, 2021, meeting was approved.

Discussion: 2022 Project Selection Process

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, provided an update on preparations for the 2022 Project Selection process, including a summary of recent discussions of the Executive Board related to the earned share distribution methodology for FTA funds and noted this item will not be discussed at the Project Selection Task Force. She said potential next steps would be the formation of a subgroup consisting of Executive Board members to review the Earned Share methodology, and that PSRC will propose that representatives from all agencies will be involved. She mentioned that if there are any changes to the Earned Share methodology, it may slightly affect funding distribution timelines.

Discussion: Regional Transportation Plan Future Visioning for Transit

Gil Cerise, PSRC, reviewed future visioning for transit in the RTP that included using the information from projects in the Regional Capacity Project list for the new RTP and the upcoming visualization tool of planned transit service for the 2022-2050 timeframe. He noted these can provide assistance with long- range planning and transit investments for jurisdictions and agencies. Kelly reported that the visualization tool will be shown at the next Transportation Policy Board for discussion and feedback on future regional transportation needs that may provide additional insights for the RTP.

Discussion: Coordinated Mobility Plan Draft Prioritized Strategies and Associated Mobility Needs

Gil and Kim Pearson, PSRC, provided an overview of the work completed to-date on identification of mobility needs and challenges through outreach to people with special transportation needs, and the process to identify strategies associated with each mobility need/challenge. They explained several of the needs and strategies and the feedback received by the public outreach, such as long travel times, limited service times, and cost. Gil then reviewed next steps which included continuing to meet with community groups for confirmation

on desired mobility outcomes and prioritize strategies to achieve them. He noted the draft plan is scheduled to be released for public comment in January 2022.
