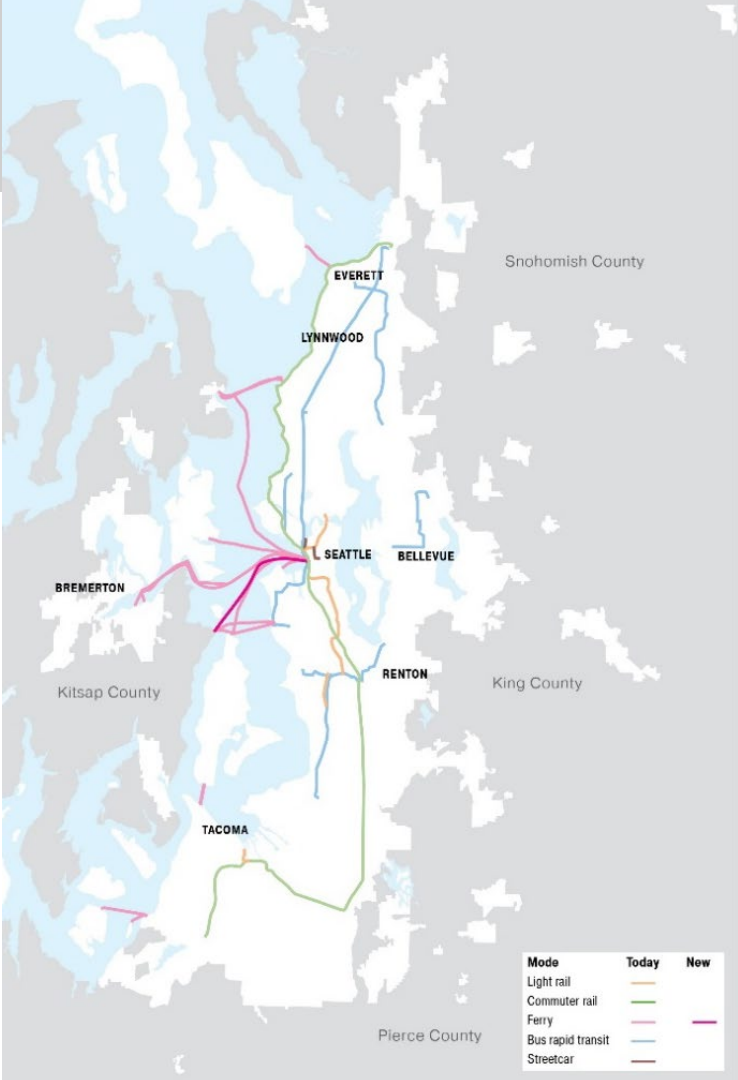
VISION 2050

Vision 2050 Transportation Goal

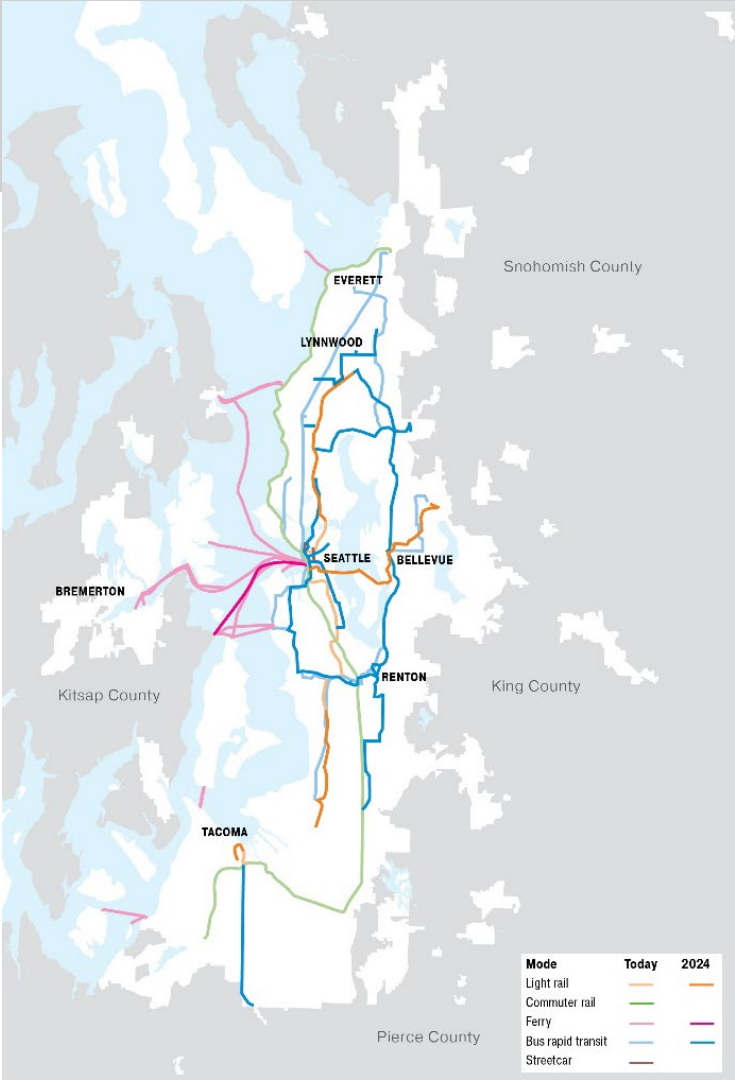
