Fatality Risk Goes Up Over 25 MPH






Top Causes of Workplace Injury and Fatality





Daily Vehicle-Miles Traveled
















Motor Vehicle Death Rate: January-May 2019 vs. 2020




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Motor Vehicle Miles Driven: January-May 2019 vs. 2020



Motor Vehicle Deaths: January-May 2019 vs. 2020




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
Motor Vehicle Data: January-May 2019 vs. 2020

Federal Actions

116th CONGRESS 2d Session



AN ACT

To authorize funds for Federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Moving Forward Act".
