Welcome and Introduction to Online Meeting Format

Geri Poor, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. Roll call was completed to confirm the members and alternates present.

Action: Approval of Meeting Summary

The April 13, 2022 meeting summary was approved as presented.

Action: CUFC Designation Process - Recommendation for the CUFC Designations

Jennifer Barnes, PSRC, provided a brief overview of the 2022 CUFC designation/NHFP funding processes and overall Critical Urban Freight Corridor (CUFC) designation process and timeline. She reminded the committee that the review of the candidate CUFC segment list and the criteria/considerations to apply to reduce the list, was to adhere to the region's mileage limit and apply those considerations to determine the committee's recommended CUFC list for the region. She provided an overview of the updated draft candidate corridor list that was refined in coordination with jurisdictions and noted that this special May meeting was scheduled to conclude the committee's recommendation from the last meeting.

The Committee members reviewed and discussed the refined candidate CUFC segment list, to determine the committee's final recommended CUFC list for the region. A list was established, but the committee did not take action at this meeting as there were some clarifications requested by members before finalizing the list. Jennifer said that PSRC would do some outreach to address details discussed, and then have a final list to the committee for action at the June meeting.

Jennifer then provided a brief overview of the WSDOT rural corridor designation process that PSRC will be reaching out to those that are eligible to begin the process of determining a list to submit to WSDOT. Jason Beloso, WSDOT, noted that the allocations are still being worked on as the WSDOT technical working group is still working through different approaches to solidify the designated miles. Jennifer noted that the timeline is a completion date by July, and a request for these corridors will be sent out once WSDOT finalizes the allocations.

Discussion: Other Business and Announcements

Jennifer reminded the committee about the information that Brian Ziegler, FMSIB, provided at the last meeting, regarding the Freight Mobility Strategic Investment Board (FMSIB) compilation of a statewide list of prioritized freight investments at the direction of the state legislature, due to be completed by August. Brian said that PSRC will coordinate submittal of projects for the region and will be sending out the template spreadsheet that provides the specific information on the criteria for what projects can be submitted to be eligible for funding and noted that one of the conditions for this list is that freight improvement projects must be ready for construction in the next six years. Jennifer noted the due date for projects is later in the next few months this summer and that the template and information will be sent out soon.

Jason Beloso, WSDOT, announced that WSDOT will have a public webinar in about two weeks ("*Moving Freight in Washington State*") that provides a presentation on part the Freight System Plan update, that includes data analysis efforts.
