### Regional Project Evaluation Committee Meeting Summary Date: February 25, 2022 from 9:30 a.m.-11:00 a.m. Location: Remote – Online Meeting Only (Zoom Connection)

### Introductions, Review of Meeting Procedures and Announcements

Doug McCormick, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. and announced that Amy Fowler, alternate representative for PSCAA, is now the member, and the new alternate for PSCAA is now Kathy Strange. He then took a roll call to confirm the members and alternates present.

### **Approval of Meeting Summary**

The January 28, 2022, RPEC meeting summary was approved as presented.

### **Transportation Policy Board Debrief**

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, reviewed the Transportation Policy Board meeting held Thursday, February 10, 2022. The 'At Work' report for this meeting is available on the PSRC website at: <u>https://www.psrc.org/tpb-meetings</u>.

### **Discussion: Project Extensions and Annual Delivery Target**

Kelly reported on the requested 2022 obligation date extensions, current obligation delivery, and next steps in the rebalancing process over the next few months. She said the intention is for RPEC/Countywide Chairs to review the extension requests in March to forward for board approval in April. Next steps will be to work on the rebalancing process and she noted advanced projects or new funding awards as part of that process will have until July 15th for the obligation deadline.

### **Discussion: 2022 Project Selection Process**

Kelly reported that the Call for Projects was released on February 11 and reviewed key dates for the Regional FHWA competition. She reminded the committee that the schedule, materials, application links, resources and guidance documents can be found on the PSRC website on the <u>FHWA and FTA Regional Funding page</u>. She then reviewed the additional funds to distribute from 2021 HIP funding and 2021 CRRSAA FHWA funding as part of 2022 process. She noted that the distribution splits will be finalized in consultation with RPEC/Countywide chairs and then the increased funding levels will be communicated out to prospective sponsors.

Amy Fowler, PSCAA, also announced at this time that PSCAA has determined they will be using only one of their two CMAQ application slots for this Project Selection round. PSCAA will consider brief applications from other agencies for projects that include significant diesel emissions reductions.

### Discussion: Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill / Federal Transportation Funding

Kelly shared information regarding 2022-2026 federal funding that is anticipated to flow through PSRC. She noted there will be an overall increase in funding, including for PSRC formula funding programs, but amounts between the state and MPOs/RTPOs is uncertain at this time. Final information on the FHWA funding split between the state and local agencies (i.e., through MPOs/RTPOs or WSDOT Local Programs) is still to be determined. She noted discussions for this are expected to occur after the Legislative session.
