PSRC Budget Overview

- The Puget Sound Regional Council operates under a two-year (biennial) budget and work program
- Administrative adjustments to carryover amount done in fall
- Can be adjusted after the first year with a supplemental budget or budget amendment
- PSRC's FY 2022-2023 Supplemental Budget and Work Program reflects agency revenues and expenditure of \$32,016,000



PSRC Budget Approval Process

- Late 2021: Draft FY 2022-2023 Supplemental Budget and Work Program developed
- Jan/Feb 2022: Draft supplemental budget provided to PSRC boards and committees for feedback
- March 2022: Operations Committee recommended approval of the budget by Executive Board
- April 2022: Executive Board recommended budget for adoption at PSRC's General Assembly
- May 2022: General Assembly adopted the FY 2022-2023 Supplemental Budget and Work Program

CPSEDD Budget Background

- Central Puget Sound Economic Development District (CPSEDD) is chartered as a non-profit in the State of Washington
- PSRC & CPSEDD operate under Memorandum of Agreement
- PSRC maintains audited financial statements for both PSRC and CPSEDD
 - PSRC Economic Development District (Task 300) serves as CPSEDD budget
- Economic Development program funded multiple ways by PSRC
 - Task 300 includes only revenues and expenses specifically tied to the EDD
 - Economic Development program funded through Task 300 as well as other PSRC budget tasks as needed
- EDD must take additional action to approve Task 300 as CPSEDD budget
