We have multiple funding cycles:

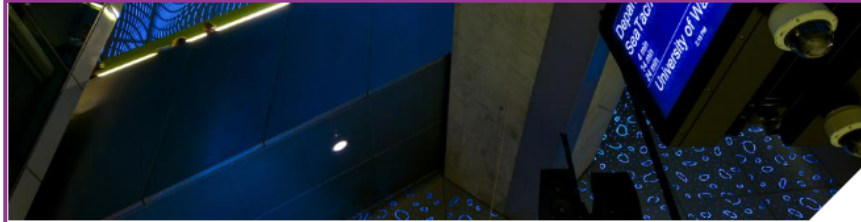

- On July 26, 2022, the 32nd anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act, FTA [announced](#) approximately \$343 million available for Fiscal Year 2022 grants for the All Stations Accessibility Program (ASAP). The Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) will make it easier for people with disabilities to access the nation's oldest subway, commuter rail and light rail stations.
