Discussion: FMSIB Statewide Freight Investment Priority List

Jennifer Barnes, PSRC, reminded the committee of the process and status of the Statewide Freight Investment Priority database that is under development by the Freight Mobility Strategic Investment Board (FMSIB) in cooperation with MPOs/RTPOs. She provided a briefing on the freight investment projects submitted by agencies for submittal to FMSIB and noted that PSRC had received 58 projects which were being compiled to be submitted by August 15. She said to email her by Friday, August 12, if there was anything else to be added. Brian Ziegler, FMSIB, reminded the committee that the compilation of a statewide list of prioritized freight investments is at the direction of the state legislature and reviewed eligibility and prioritization criteria and how these are related to the process. The committee discussed and provided comments.
