Introductions, Review of Meeting Procedures and Announcements

Russ Blount, Vice Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. He then took a roll call to confirm the members and alternates present.

Approval of Meeting Summary

Transportation Policy Board Debrief

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, reminded the committee that the Transportation Policy Board did not meet in August and then reviewed the Transportation Policy Board meeting held on Thursday, September 8, 2022. Discussion: PSRC's Transportation Committees

Gil Cerise, PSRC, provided an overview of PSRC's transportation committees and reviewed the focus and purpose of each. Gil then discussed membership update procedures and the need to both fill vacant seats and ensure consistent and engaged representation on each committee. Discussion: Project Delivery Status Report and Issues

Kelly reported on the current progress towards 2022 delivery and provided information on the challenges experienced. Stephanie Tax, WSDOT, provided additional background information and details including the importance of reviewing project timelines to help meet delivery targets. Kelly reminded the committee that due to the ongoing challenges in delivering funds each year, the consequences of this may affect receipt of additional funds in the future. She indicated the need to regroup and reevaluate the current policies and processes, which can be taken up by the upcoming project delivery working group. Committee suggestions included sending a survey or

conducting interviews with jurisdictions to identify problems that may be difficult to solve, as well as best practices to share when the process went smoothly.
