


2022-2050 Regional Transportation Plan Update

- ❑ In May 2022, the General Assembly **adopted the 2022-2050 RTP**.
- ❑ Since adoption, PSRC staff have been working with the TPB and Executive Steering Committee on reviewing **implementation action items**.
- ❑ The preliminary feedback was incorporated into **draft priorities and timelines** for continuing and new work program items.



Active Transportation Plan Repackaging

- ✓ Amendment to adopted RTP to compile bike/ped information into stand-alone Active Transportation Plan (ATP)
- ✓ ATP will include bike/ped data and analysis and identified needs and priorities from RTP
- ✓ ATP will help inform future regional and local planning



Bike/Ped RTP Work Program Items

Bicycle- and pedestrian-related work program items arising from the RTP:

- ✓ Bicycle and pedestrian **data updates**, including input on “all ages and abilities” facilities
- ✓ Updates to **transit access guidance** and resources
- ✓ **ADA transition plan** technical assistance (2023 timeframe)



Other Related RTP Work Program Items

There are several other related transportation work program items from the RTP for BPAC input, including:

- ✓ Identify **regional performance measures** and targets and create online dashboard
- ✓ Produce **Regional Safety Plan** and related safety work
- ✓ Support for **emerging transportation technology**, like e-bikes
- ✓ Integrating **equity** into regional transportation planning



Bike/Ped Work Program Next Steps

Continued work from adopted RTP:

- Feedback on Active Transportation Plan repackaging

Upcoming work program items in early 2023:

- Preparation for bike/ped facility inventory update
- Input on definitions of “all ages and abilities” facilities
- Ongoing feedback on transit access updates and analysis
- Input on other bike/ped related items in transportation work program
