Monitoring & Adaptive Management

A systematic process to continually evaluate and improve the effectiveness of critical areas policies, regulations, and practices by learning from feedback loops and the outcomes of implementation.



5. Modify the Permit Process



1. Identify Key Questions:

- Did the county/city issue a complete and fully compliant permit?
- · Did the applicant comply?



Adaptive Management Feedback Loop for Permit Systems



- Permit process steps
- Permit compliance



4. Recommend Solutions and Actions:

- Revise application forms
- Train staff
- Revise administrative interpretations
- Revise policies or regulations



3. Evaluate Monitoring Results:

- · Are benchmarks met?
- Are changes needed?

Why Monitoring & Adaptive Management?

- Critical areas program that is fair, effective, efficient, successful
 - Are regulations achieving their goals for the community?
 - Improve quality and speed of permitting
 - Transparency in the permit process
 - Reduce risk from land use impacts
 - Improved ecological outcomes


Types of Monitoring

Permit Implementation

- Ensures that regulations are followed each time a permit is issued
 - Did the local government issue a permit consistent with regulations?
 - Did the projects as built comply with all permit conditions?

Permit effectiveness

 Ensures that regulations are implemented consistently over time



Developing a Monitoring & Adaptive Management Program

- 1. Determine the Reasons for Monitoring for Adaptive Management
- 2. Establish Key Objectives and Study Questions
- 3. Design the Monitoring Program
- 4. Determine the Monitoring Time Frame
- 5. Evaluate Results and Make Recommendations

Adaptive Management Strategies

- Create a better training program for staff
- Educate applicants and property owners about the permit process
- Improve the application process and forms
- Improve the monitoring reporting process
- Refine development regulations so they are easier to apply consistently and correctly

Resources and Funding for Monitoring & Adaptive Management

- Local Monitoring & Adaptive Management Financing
 - Integrate monitoring into permit review process and use permit fees to pay for ongoing work
