Core Economic Development Program Funding

U.S. EDA Partnership Planning Grant

- Partnership Planning Program grant from the U.S. EDA
- Provides EDD with \$100k/year. Required 100% local match
- Local match provided by dues collected from PSRC's membership
- Current 3-year grant cycle ends 3/2023
- The EDD has been invited to apply to the FY2023-FY2025 Partnership Planning Program, which would renew funding through 3/2025

Additional Program Funding

CARES Act

- EDD awarded \$400,000 in CARES Act funding from EDA. No local match Supported update to new Regional Economic Strategy
- Funded Workforce Recovery Planning project and Arts & Culture Recovery Strategy

• PSRC provides additional funds for economic development staffing and initiatives through other budget items

• Operations Committee review revenue and expenditure assumptions and policies

December 2022

• Full draft FY 2024-2025 Biennial Budget and Work Program released

January-March 2023

• Comments forwarded to Operations Committee by March 12

March 2023

- Operations Committee submits Final Draft Budget and Work Program to Executive Board
- Executive Board transmits Final Draft Budget to the General Assembly

May 2023

• General Assembly adopts Final Draft Budget

June 2023

• EDD adopts Economic Development element




