Goals of SPA

- Introduce individuals to the planning process and profession at an early age.
- Engage young people on a regular basis to provide input on PSRC's policies and programs.
- Promote equity in the region by actively recruiting and engaging youth from diverse backgrounds including Black, Indigenous, and people of color (BIPOC) communities, low-income residents, and people with disabilities.



Development Process

- Informational interviews with peer MPOs.
 - Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP)
 - Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC)-Bay Area
 - Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG)
- Modeling program after CMAP program.
 - Future Leaders in Planning (FLIP)
- Funding set aside in the budget to begin in 2023.



2023 Cohort

- No more than 20 high school students.
 - Focusing on rising juniors and seniors.
- Representation from all four counties.
 - Direct outreach to students from marginalized communities.
- Students eligible for \$500 scholarship at program completion.




2023 Cohort
