Biennial update to the Freight and Goods Transportation System (FGTS) is currently underway

- Statewide update led by WSDOT
- > PSRC facilitating data collection for jurisdictions within the region for cities and ports in King, Pierce, and Snohomish counties
 - Counties' data being coordinated by the County Road Administration Board (CRAB)
 - Jurisdictions within Kitsap County being coordinated by the Peninsula Regional Transportation Planning Organization (PRTPO)



PSRC process:

- > Solicitations sent to FAC and countywide forum email lists on April 6
- > WSDOT excel workbook sent with existing FGTS route and volume data
- Agencies asked to send back workbook with updated information for FGTS facilities within their jurisdiction/district
 - Review existing FGTS facilities and data
 - Provide updated Average Daily Traffic (ADT), truck count, and truck tonnage data where available (collected since June 2021)
 - Include data to support requests for new FGTS facilities, if applicable



PSRC process:

- > Completed workbooks with updated data due to PSRC by May 5
- > PSRC will conduct cursory review of submitted data
 - Will follow up with jurisdictions if there are obvious gaps to be filled or clarifications needed
 - Will not be vetting/validating data that is provided (but WSDOT will!)
- > PSRC will compile the updated data into a regional list for submittal to WSDOT prior to June deadline
- Remaining process completed by WSDOT

Freight Work Program

Regional Transportation Plan – FAC Role:

- Serve as forum to compile best practices for design, management, and operation of freight transportation, and examples of solutions to freight problems within varying contexts
- Work with PSRC to serve as a clearinghouse to help partner agencies share this information
- Serve as forum to support partnerships to address and prioritize regional freight issues, and leverage resources to address regional freight priorities




Freight Topic Priorities/Expertise – FAC Poll

- > FAC interested parties also welcome to respond if you have relevant freight information you would like to share




Survey Topics:

- For each of eight priority freight topics, indicate if you have experience/examples you can share

 - Note, feasibility of PSRC facilitating some potential forums is unknown, but want to gauge potential interest before exploring further

Other Areas of Expertise/Experience Identified


- > Inland container freight terminal assessment

Lead Time




Format for Sharing Information
