

Ped/Bike Facility Inventory Update Purpose



- The Regional Transportation Plan calls for PSRC to maintain state-of-the-practice analysis and data.
- The ped/bike facility inventory provides baseline data for informing regional planning and identifying needs/gaps.
- The inventory update will help ensure data remains accurate and current.



Facility Inventory Background

- The facility inventory was last updated in 2020.
- Per the regional thresholds, the inventory includes:
 - Ped/bike facilities on or adjacent to arterial roadways and;
 - Shared use facilities on separate rights-of-way providing connections between destinations.



Inventory Update Work Program

1. Revise the current inventory to account for any changes to facility terminology, categorizations and criteria from updated facility typology.
2. Gather feedback on needed updates to current inventory from local jurisdictional partners, including new or modified facilities.
3. Update the inventory based on feedback received from jurisdictional partners, including final review.

Next Steps

- Inventory update work will begin in Summer 2023.
- PSRC will provide ongoing updates to BPAC on progress.
