

Regional Growth



- We're planning for 1.4 million more people
- VISION 2050 establishes a framework for regional growth
- 2044 population, housing, and employment growth targets for communities have been set through the countywide process



Housing Affordability



- We need 800k more housing units, and region is behind on housing production
- Housing requirements have changed since the last update
- Many communities will need more capacity and new tools for affordability



Racial Inequities



Past and current housing practices have perpetuated substantial inequities in wealth, ownership, and opportunity

• BIPOC households tend to pay a greater share of their income on housing than white households



Climate Change



- Urgent environmental, economic, and equity threat requiring coordinated action
- Substantial emission reduction goals for 2030 and 2050
- VISION addresses climate change
- New legislation (HB 1181) will require a stand-alone climate element by 2029


Transit Investments
