Regional Technology and Innovation Hubs

Goal:

Strengthen U.S. economic and national security through place-based investments in geographically diverse regions across the country with a concentration of assets, resources, and capacity aligned with the potential to become globally competitive, within approximately ten years, in the technologies and industries of the future—and for those industries, companies, and the good jobs they create, to start, grow, and remain in the U.S.

Eligibility:

Consortia consisting of higher education, state/local government, industry groups or firms, ED organizations, labor/workforce.

Regional Technology and Innovation Hubs

Phase 1

- Designation of 20+ Tech Hubs across the country
- ~\$15 million in strategy development grants to accelerate the development of future Tech Hubs
- Estimated \$400k grant with \$100k local match
- Designation separate from strategy grants
- Applications due 8/15/2023

Phase 2

- Open only to designated Tech Hubs
- ~\$50-\$75m funding across 3-8 projects per selected Tech Hubs
- NOFO to be released in fall





Recompete Pilot Program

Program will provide grant funding to distressed communities across the country to create, and connect workers to, good jobs and support long-term comprehensive economic development by helping to reduce the high, prime-age (25 to 54 years of age) employment gap.

NOFO is expected to be released in the first half of 2023
