

Freight Advisory Committee Meeting Summary

Date: August 09, 2023, 9:30a.m. - 11:00a.m.

Location: Remote – Online Meeting Only (Zoom Meeting)

Welcome and Introductions

Geri Poor, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. Roll call was completed to confirm the members and alternates present.

Action: Approval of Meeting Summary

The June 14, 2022, meeting summary was approved as presented.

Discussion: PSRC Travel Models

Craig Helmann, PSRC, provided an overview of PSRC's travel demand models, including the truck model component of the activity-based demand model, and facilitated committee discussion on freight modeling. Discussion included model data sources including ATRI, INRIX, and local truck counts; the use of Port and warehouse special generators; truck sizes evaluated; and land use assumptions applied to support freight travel analysis. Craig clarified that freight truck forecasts are primarily count based and not directly based on commodity flow forecasts, but through work with our Port partners can be influenced by port truck data that reflects their own commodity flow forecasts. Finally, the group discussed how PSRC's models can potentially be applied to evaluate specific land use or transportation projects with freight transportation impacts; typically, PSRC provides the regional model data to a project team that uses that as the starting point for their more detailed modeling to test specific projects or scenarios. As follow-up to the day's discussion, prior to the next model update PSRC will provide information on the locations of freight special generators and truck counts and invite feedback from the committee.

Discussion: PSRC Freight Inventory and Data Collection

Jennifer Barnes, PSRC, provided an overview of the freight assets inventory update that will be initiated this fall and will support the next Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) that will be adopted in 2026. The current inventory data includes freight assets such as Freight & Goods Transportation System (FGTS) designated facilities, railway, port, intermodal facilities, and land use, demographic, and infrastructure data that can help inform freight transportation analysis. Items of interest identified by the committee included congestion along freight routes and truck parking. Wenjuan Zhao, WSDOT, shared with the committee that the statewide Freight System Plan has a truck parking element that includes an inventory and hotspot analysis, and other freight data sources such as a Commodities Flow Dashboard. At the next meeting, PSRC staff will present a summary of the freight inventory data previously collected and ask the committee to provide input on whether there are other types of data or sources that could or should be considered in the update.

Wenjuan Zhao, WSDOT, provide a status update on the FGTS update, which is due to be completed by December 2023. Cecile Malik, Auburn, asked the group about a solicitation from an advocacy group opposing a federal bill (HR3372) that would pilot test raising truck weight limits. Jennifer Barnes, PSRC, and Geri Poor, Port of Seattle, will check with their agencies' government relations staff to check for information about the status/likelihood of the bill.
