






Vehicle Registrations by Electrification Level






Vehicle Miles Traveled



Daily Vehicle Miles per Capita













Annual Traffic Related Deaths












Traffic Related Deaths by Race




Traffic Related Deaths per 100,000 people: 2022

Jobs near HCT











Annual Transit Boardings



Annual Transit Boardings




Recovery has varied by mode. Light Rail and Ferry modes are closest to prepandemic levels.

Commuter Rail and Vanpools, which are highly dependent on workers in major employment centers, continue to recover at slower rates.






Ratio of Boardings to Pre-Pandemic: 2023






Morning Congestion








Afternoon Congestion
