Welcome and Introductions

Susan Carter, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. and took a roll call of the membership in attendance.

Approval of Meeting Summary

The January 17, 2024 meeting summary was approved as presented.

Discussion: PSRC Transportation Committee Assessment

Gil Cerise, PSRC, shared an overview of PSRC's effort to re-evaluate transportation planning committees. Jean Kim, PSRC, then reviewed a plan to rebrand SNTC and shared a draft document that will provide the basis for revised operating procedures for the committee. The draft document included revised the committee purpose statement and key work program areas that closely align with the Regional Transportation Plan. The committee reviewed the revision and provided feedback. PSRC will share revised SNTC operating procedures and proposed membership structure at the May meeting.

Discussion: Preparation for the 2024 PSRC Regional Priority Ranking Process

Jean provided an overview of the regional priority ranking process and an updated schedule for the state's 2025-27 Consolidated Grant competition. She reviewed a variety of factors used for PSRC application assessment and SNTC deliberation in 2022. Erin Hogan, PSRC, shared a summary of how other peer regions incorporated equity into similar specialized transportation grant programs, including FTA 5310. Jean and Erin shared staff proposals to further weave equity considerations into our region's priority ranking process. Staff will engage the PSRC Equity Advisory Committee in April. Staff will share final proposal to update the regional priority ranking factors taking into consideration the EAC's input for the SNTC review at the May meeting.
