Central Puget Sound Economic Development District Board Wednesday, March 6, 2024 Hybrid Meeting - PSRC Board Room – 1201 Third Avenue, Suite 500, Seattle, 98101

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting of the Central Puget Sound Economic Development District Board of Directors was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Axel Strakeljahn, President. To determine attendance and a quorum was present, a verbal roll call was conducted by staff.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

President Strakeljahn shared that today his term as President will end. The Nominating Committee will propose Councilmember Lee as President and Councilmember Morell as Vice President. In addition, both Presidential Appointments and Executive Committee membership will be brought forth for ratification by the board. Following these items, PSRC Director of Government Relations and Communications, Robin Koskey, will provide the board with a WA State Legislative update. Other briefings include Regional Workforce Development efforts, led by William Dowling, Director of the Olympic WDC, and the Greater Seattle Partners work program, led by Brian Surratt, President & CEO, and Rebecca Lovell, COO, of Greater Seattle Partners.

<u>ACTION</u>: It was moved and seconded (Stern/Morell) to adopt the Consent Agenda. The motion passed. Commissioner Simpson and Councilmember Rhyne abstained.

ACTION ITEM: ELECTION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD OFFICERS

The bylaws of the Central Puget Sound Economic Development District state that the Board of Directors must elect their President and Vice President for a two-year term at the Annual Meeting. The nominating committee recommended Councilmember Lee as President and Councilmember Morell as Vice President for the 2024-2026 term:

<u>ACTION</u>: It was moved and seconded (Assefa-Dawson/Greer) to approve the Nominating Committee's recommendation of Councilmember Conrad Lee as President and Councilmember Dave Morell as Vice President, for the 2024-2026 term. The motion passed.

ACTION ITEM: RATIFICATION OF PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTMENTS

The Bylaws of the Central Puget Sound Economic Development District give the board President authority to make appointments to the board to ensure adequate representation and diversity in the makeup of the board. The central Puget Sound region's Local Workforce Development Boards provided an update on statewide and regional workforce development initiatives, including recent investments in the Economic Security for All initiative. The briefing was led by William Dowling, Director, Olympic WDC.

DISCUSSION ITEM: GREATER SEATTLE PARTNERS

Greater Seattle Partners (GSP), a regional public-private economic development organization focused on global business attraction, site selection and promoting investment and trade opportunities in the region, provided an update on recent work and planned efforts for 2024. The briefing was led by Brian Surratt, President & CEO, and Rebecca Lovell, COO, Greater Seattle Partners.
