2. Regional Transportation Plan (2026-2050) – TDM Existing Conditions (10:10)

PSRC will provide an overview of the Regional Transportation Plan – including the current plan (2022-2050) and the development of the new plan in progress (2026-2050). The new RTP (2026-2050) will also meet the requirements of the Regional Commute Trip Reduction Plan.

3. Findings from the 2023 Regional Household Travel Survey (10:30)

PSRC data staff will share key findings from the 2023 Regional Household Travel Survey relevant to TDM, including comparing the results to past survey datasets. This data will inform the TDM existing conditions and trends element of the RTP (2026-2050).

4. Local CTR Plans – Progress and PSRC Review (11:15)

PSRC will provide a reminder of the process for regional review of draft local CTR plans ahead of the **September 20** deadline for submittal. Although PSRC's review is focused on consistency of local plans with regional plans, local CTR plans will also inform the RTP (2026-2050). Additionally, this will be an opportunity for stakeholders working on plans to ask questions of PSRC and/or peer jurisdictions.
