





Left Side:


- Ped Completeness

Reconciling Right and Left Sides of Inventory Segments



Pedestrian Facilities:
Complete + Complete = Complete Facilities

Bicycle Facilities: Complete + No Facilities = **Partial Facilities**

Other Situations:


- Complete + Complete = Complete
- No facilities + No facilities = No Facilities
- Complete + Partial = Partial Facilities
- Complete + No facilities = Partial Facilities
- No facilities + Partial = Partial Facilities
- Partial + Partial = Partial Facilities





Facility Coverage:


The mileage of complete or partial ped/bike facilities divided by the mileage of roadway facilities in the given geography.

Arterials and Above:


Principal and Minor Arterials with a small selection of Urban Expressway facilities along SR 99




Percent of Sidewalk Coverage on Arterials* by County




Mileage of Pedestrian Facilities on Arterials* by County






Percent of Bicycle Coverage on Arterials* by County



Mileage of Bicycle Facilities on Arterials* by County










Percent of Sidewalk Coverage in Urban and Rural Areas




Percent of Bicycle Coverage in Urban and Rural Areas








Percent of Sidewalk Coverage in Equity Focus Areas*




People with Low Income, 2019




Percent of Sidewalk Coverage in Equity Focus Areas*








Percent of Bicycle Coverage in Equity Focus Areas*









Percent of Bicycle Coverage in Equity Focus Areas*






Sidewalk Coverage in RGCs, HCT, and general Station Areas




Bicycle Coverage in RGCs, HCT, and general Station Areas




Shared Use Paths in RGCs, HCT, and general Station Areas






Paved Shoulders in Urban and Rural Areas
