- The opening of the link light rail to Lynnwood was a huge milestone for our regional transportation and gets us one step closer to light rail to Everett.
- Given we are moving into the next phase of development of light rail in Snohomish County, I think it is time to re-evaluate the governance structure of the board.
- Snohomish County only has three seats, to Pierce County's 4 and King County's 10. It would be good to add some representation for Snohomish County on the ST board in light of the transition to this next phase of construction.
