








## Age Distribution of U District






**Total Population by Race & Ethnicity** 









- Many walking paths in the UW








# Land Use

# Housing


- Mainly student housing; dorms, apartments, fraternities.

- Soccer field, parks, basketball courts, and other amenities.






# Housing Tenure (2012)

### Share of Households by Housing Tenure








# Housing Density (2022)








## Renter Cost Burden (2012)

### **Share of Renter Households by Cost Burden**




