# Project Selection – Equity Pilot Program



- In January 2024, completed pilot program that began in January 2023 in close coordination with Equity Advisory Committee (EAC)
- 8 projects awarded \$6.4 million, included safety projects, pedestrian improvements, trail extension, bus shelter improvements, directed to Equity Focus Areas
- EAC evaluation of two potential tracks informed the equity component of the 2024 Project Selection process



# 2024 Project Selection

136 projects recommended for total of ~\$712 million in awards

FTA	FHWA
Earned Share Formula ~\$409 million	Regional Competition ~\$96 million
Equity Formula ~\$64 million	Four Countywide Competitions ~\$143 million



# FTA Awards – Project Outcomes




35 projects awarded FTA funds, including 7 receiving Equity Formula funds. These include:

- High-Capacity Transit expansion
- Vehicle purchases
- Passenger access improvements and amenities
- Fast Ferry docking facility
- Transit infrastructure (e.g., trolley poles/switches)
- Vehicle and transit facility maintenance




# FHWA Awards – Multiple Project Outcomes



- 18 projects awarded in regional competition
- 83 projects awarded in four countywide competitions



# New Transportation Improvement Program




Covers years 2025-2028,

- 435 projects programmed, most include multiple outcomes
- \$9.6 billion programmed, representing \$44 billion in total investments in the region



# Project Outcomes in New 2025-2028 TIP





- 202 projects located on designated freight routes






PSRC Region delivered 77 projects with total of ~\$123 million in FHWA funds








