## Discussion: Regional Capacity Project Thresholds for Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, shared background information on the current Regional Capacity Project Thresholds, including details on the previous BPAC input that led to the current thresholds for pedestrian and bicycle facilities. Committee members asked various questions about how these thresholds are interpreted and which elements are flexible given the limitations of federal requirements. PSRC staff clarified and responded to these questions and shared that the committee will have another opportunity to suggest edits to the current thresholds at the January BPAC meeting.
