Growth Management Policy Board Thursday, November 7, 2024 1201 3rd Ave., Ste 500, Seattle, WA 98101

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Council President Ed Prince, Chair.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Chair Prince welcomed the board members to the meeting.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Growth Management Director Paul Inghram welcomed the board and gave an update on the review of draft comprehensive plans, introduced the topics for the meeting and noted that there is no December meeting for the board and that the January meeting will shift to January 16, 2025 to accommodate the new year holiday.

CONSENT AGENDA

 a. Approve Minutes of Growth Management Policy Board Meeting held October 3, 2024.

<u>ACTION</u>: It was moved and seconded (Dunn/Buxton) to adopt the Consent Agenda. The motion passed.

DISCUSSION ITEM: 2024 HOUSING MONITORING UPDATE: THE STATE OF THE REGION'S HOUSING

PSCR staff presented the 2024 housing monitoring report to the board, which includes data and analysis on the region's housing supply, affordability and production. The 2024 update shows that residents still struggle to access housing within their housing budget, as most renters are cost burdened. Housing production has increased, but to meet the region's goals, 15,000 units will be needed annually. With comprehensive plan updates, local jurisdictions are planning for housing at all income levels, allowing for different types of middle housing and addressing barriers to housing development. PSRC's Regional Housing Strategy stems from VISION 2050's plan of meeting the housing and affordability needs of residents in the region. PSRC will continue to track and monitor the region's housing landscape. The board discussed additional issues around housing including income restricted housing, the growing housing disparity gap and the connection between building housing and environmental and open space planning.

DISCUSSION ITEM: REGIONAL SAFETY ACTION PLAN DEVELOPMENT

The board was briefed on the development of PSRC's Regional Safety Action Plan. PSRC was awarded two planning grants through USDOT's Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program and started to develop the Regional Safety Action Plan (RSAP). Throughout the summer and fall, PSRC staff and consultants conducted public outreach, tabling at events, facilitating four regional public meetings and the opening of the RSAP Engagement Hub, which provided information to the public on how they can participate in the development of the plan. The board was presented with key data findings and a preliminary menu of tools and strategies developed for the next steps. The plan is scheduled to be adopted in the spring of 2025. The board discussion included the High Injury Network, and other issues including outreach, education and enforcement.

DISCUSSION ITEM: TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT EVENTS RECAP

The board reviewed this year's Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) event series. This year, PSRC organized two TOOLBOX webinars to highlight work to advance equitable TOD. A session on Transit Oriented Communities focused on planning around transit to include human-centered considerations like open space, arts and community activation. The Preventing Commercial Displacement session focused on the work to address the displacement commercial stores experience when neighborhoods change. Both sessions are available on the TOOLBOX series webpage.
