2025 Extension Requests


- 45-day extension
 - o Can still deliver this year but need a little more time
 - If approved, moves obligation deadline from June 1 to July 15, 2025, and does not add to current year delivery gap
- One-year extension
 - Cannot deliver by this year's obligation deadline
 - If approved, moves deadline from June 1, 2025, to June 1, 2026
 - If not approved, funds would need to be returned
 - Either way, funds are added to current year delivery gap



2025 Extension Requests

- Extension requests due on February 15
- All requests reviewed by PSRC, WSDOT, and RPEC/Countywide Chairs
 - Make determination on 45-day requests
 - Make recommendation to Board on 1-year requests
- Follow-up as needed with sponsors in February and early March
- Report out to RPEC at March meeting
- Extension requests with chairs/staff recommendations brought to April board meetings for final action




To Fill the FHWA Delivery Gap...

5-Step TIP Rebalancing Process (in order):

- 1. Advance projects from later years of the TIP
- 2. Exchange federal funds for local/state funds between phases of a single project, or between projects, within the same agency
- 3. Increase federal shares of awarded projects
- 4. Fund immediately-ready-to-go projects from the current adopted contingency lists
- 5. Award new funds to new projects, outside of the standard PSRC project selection process

FHWA Obligation Reminders

- PSRC's obligation deadline date by which a complete obligation package must submitted to WSDOT (or FTA flex requested)
- If a project that has already obligated receives an increased federal share, this is addressed by submitting a supplemental funding package
- Sponsors are strongly encouraged to assemble paperwork and coordinate with WSDOT concurrent to the TIP amendment process, so that the obligation package may be submitted as soon as possible after STIP approval



Timely FHWA Delivery - Pro Tips!

- Earlier and complete submittals to WSDOT fosters faster review
- Do not underestimate the time needed for NEPA review and approvals
- If the project includes new or replaced pavement, do not underestimate the time needed to confirm if ESA consultation is required – even if you're confident it is not
- RPEC reps should stay engaged in monitoring of delivery, and ensure that all staff responsible understand the obligation rules and deadlines

Timely FHWA Delivery - Pro Tips!

- Be proactive in monitoring WSDOT review status after submittal
- Be proactive communicating to PSRC any potential delivery issues as soon as you are aware of them
- Also be proactive in communicating issue resolutions or anticipated early delivery to PSRC



Next Steps

- Extension requests happening now due February 15
- Advancement requests also by February 15
- February to mid-March PSRC staff confirm advancements, exchanges, and increased federal shares with sponsors
 - Include in March TIP amendment adopted into STIP by mid-April
 - Will not require submittal of a TIP application PSRC administers
 - Will have June 1 obligation due date
- February to April confirm extensions
- March to May implement any additional rebalancing actions needed to close delivery gap
