The Equity Tracker allows users to measure and monitor disparities between different communities in the region, by analyzing a range of data indicators that are connected to our region's comprehensive plan, VISION 2050. This tool helps to provide context into reasons for past and present inequities, visualize existing conditions and historical trends, and connect these issues to potential solutions.
