# FTA Regional Requirements for Transit Performance

- Process for adoption of initial targets
- To track progress, PSRC collects previous year's actuals and next year's targets annually
- We send templates in Q1 and ask for data to be sent by early September to align with Transit Development Plans (TDPs)
- FTA Performance Measures the region tracks:
  - Transit Asset Management (TAM)
  - Transit Safety





# Transit Asset Management



- Measures:
  - Rolling Stock (exceeding Useful Life Benchmark)
  - Equipment (exceeding ULB)
  - Facilities (condition rating)
  - Infrastructure (performance restrictions)
- PSRC needs agency data to develop regional targets for 2026 RTP



# Transit Safety

- Current Measures:
  - Fatalities & Fatality Rate
  - Injuries & Injury Rate
  - Safety Events & Safety Event Rate
  - System Reliability (Mean Distance Between Failures)
- PSRC needs agency data to develop targets for 2026 RTP
- New measures from 2024 updated guidance:
  - Assaults on Transit Workers & Rate of Assaults on Transit Workers
  - Collision Rate – Pedestrian & Vehicular (new subcategory of Safety Events Measure)
  - Transit Worker Injury Rate (new subcategory of Injuries Measure)
  - Transit Worker Fatality Rate (new subcategory of Fatalities Measure)



# 2023 Actuals: Discussion Questions

- Transit Asset Management
  - Any feedback or context on buses and vans exceeding ULB?
  - Any feedback of context on non-revenue service vehicles exceeding ULB?
  - Targets for 2024 seem to be adjusted based on 2023 Actuals
- Transit Safety
  - Any feedback or context on safety events?
  - Any feedback or context on system reliability (as measured by Mean Distance Between Failures)?

- Templates for 2024 Actuals & 2025 Targets will be sent ahead of training – mid-March
- Reminders in July, August
- **Completed templates must be submitted to PSRC by September 2**
- Send PSRC new TAM plan or PTASP as they are updated
