



Roundabout at the intersection of Angeline Road and Veterans Memorial Drive


# **Existing Conditions**

#### **Existing Volumes:**

- Angeline Rd ADT 4,700
- Veterans Memorial Dr ADT 13,300
- Freight in Tons Per Year 3,723,250
- No room for bicyclists or pedestrians

- AM Peak Hour LOS D
- PM Peak Hour LOS F
- Several frustrated drivers



Looking West from Angeline Road





Looking East from Angeline Road


# Safety Improvements

### 5-year Crash History (2017-2021):

- 24 total crashes
- 8 injury crashes
- No Bike and Ped crashes but only because no room to ride or walk now

#### **Projected Crash Reduction**

- Traffic Signal 14% reduction in injury crashes
- Roundabout 88% reduction in injury crashes

The purpose of this letter is to provide our concurrence with the City of Bonney Lake's \$650K grant application for design funding from the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) Rural Town Centers and Corridors Program. If the project is selected by the PSRC, our understanding is the federal funding will be used to design a roundabout at the intersection of Angeline Road East and Veterans Memorial Drive East.

## Detour Route

- Key detour route parallel to SR 410 during peak traffic periods. June 27 collision @ on SR 410 caused traffic to divert to Veterans Memorial HWY.
- PM LOS F exacerbated when used as a detour route.



## Project Funding

- 2024/2025 Design -\$600,000 RTCC Grant Application
- 2026 Right of Way \$50,000 RTCC Grant Application
- 2027/2028 Construction- \$5,350,000

  - TIB
  - RTCC
