PURPOSE/NEED/SCOPE

- Design intersection improvements at Second Street and Pine Avenue. Includes interconnecting traffic signals, sidewalk, curbing, ADA compliant curb ramps, storm drainage improvements, and channelization and design of a roundabout.**
- Improve east-west movement along Second Street and reduce delays. Improve the Level of Service.**
- Local and regional improvements.**
- Improve pedestrian mobility – Boys and Girls Club, Averill Field and Centennial Regional Trail.**

SUPPORT OF TOWN CENTER/CORRIDOR

- Provide for more efficient corridor improving access to downtown Snohomish, a City Town Center.**
- Upgrade ADA facilities, includes replacing curb ramps and widening sidewalk around the northwest corner of the intersection.**
- Improve pedestrian safety.**



SCHEDULE AND BUDGET

- Anticipate PE/Design - First year awarded RTCC funds available.**
- PE/Design Cost Estimate - \$500,000.**
- PSRC funding request for the Design Phase is \$432,500. Remainder Local Funds (\$67,500 – 13.5%).**



CONCLUSION

- ❑ Improve mobility to and from the City's Rural Town Center (Downtown City Center) for multiple modes of transportation.
