
Local and Regional Policy Support

Relationship to Other Planned US-2 Projects





Safety and Multimodal Benefits

- Identified in Sultan's 2020 Local Road Safety Plan as a Highest Priority US 2 Corridor Safety Improvement Project
- Roundabout increases safety over minor approach stop control for all users



- Provides opportunity to cross US-2 safely to access regional transit stops and local businesses.
- Provides Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) crossings to enhance pedestrian safety and ADA requirements

Motor Vehicles

- Reduces vehicle/vehicle conflicts and speeds to reducing fatal and serious injury crashes over 75%
- Supports U-Turns for access management

Recreational Trips: Stevens Pass, Leavenworth

Freight Mobility: Everett/Seattle to Wenatchee/Spokane



Currant Project Status

- 30% design complete
- Design Documents submitted to WSDOT



Project Readiness



- US 2 public outreach campaign completed in 2022
- WSDOT Channelization Plan, ICE, Basis of design Submitted
- Local matching funds in hand; project is included in City's Transportation Impact Fee program, S.T.I.P and our local T.I.P
- Design completion planned for June 2024 <u>fully funded</u>
- Right of Way phase <u>fully funded</u> and planned to start in 2024
