

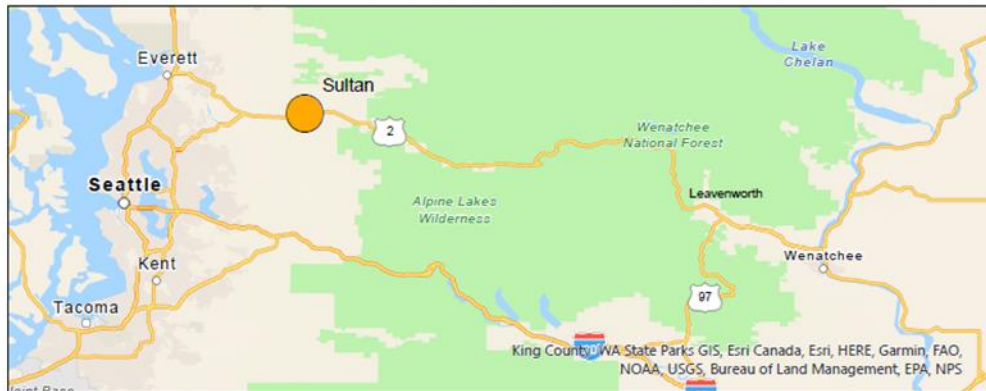
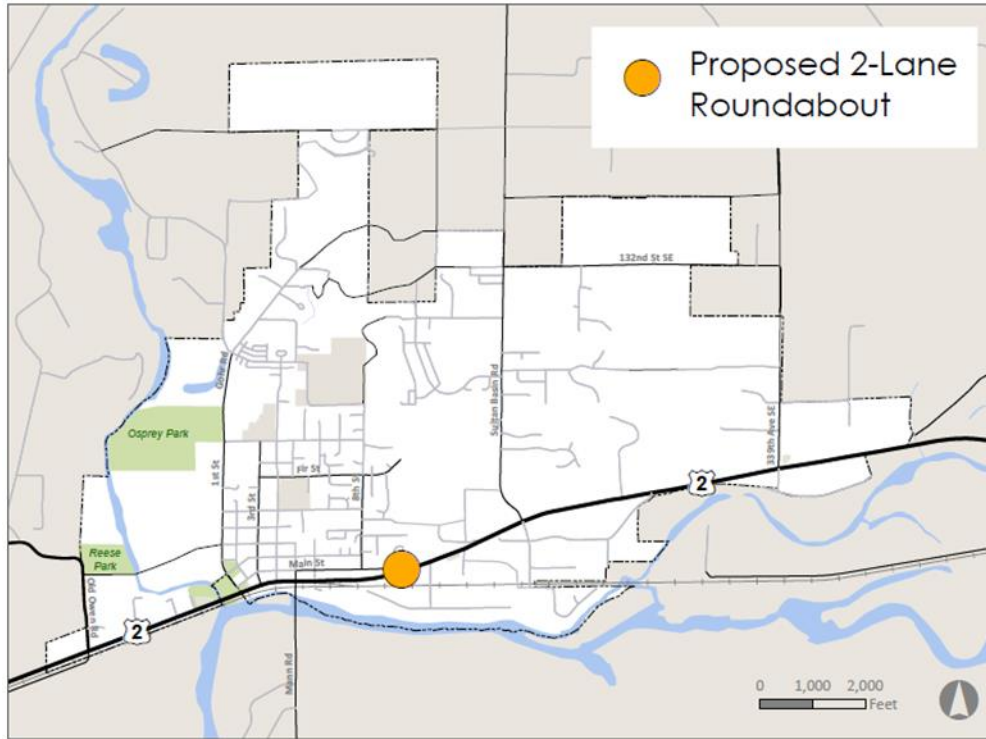

# Project Location

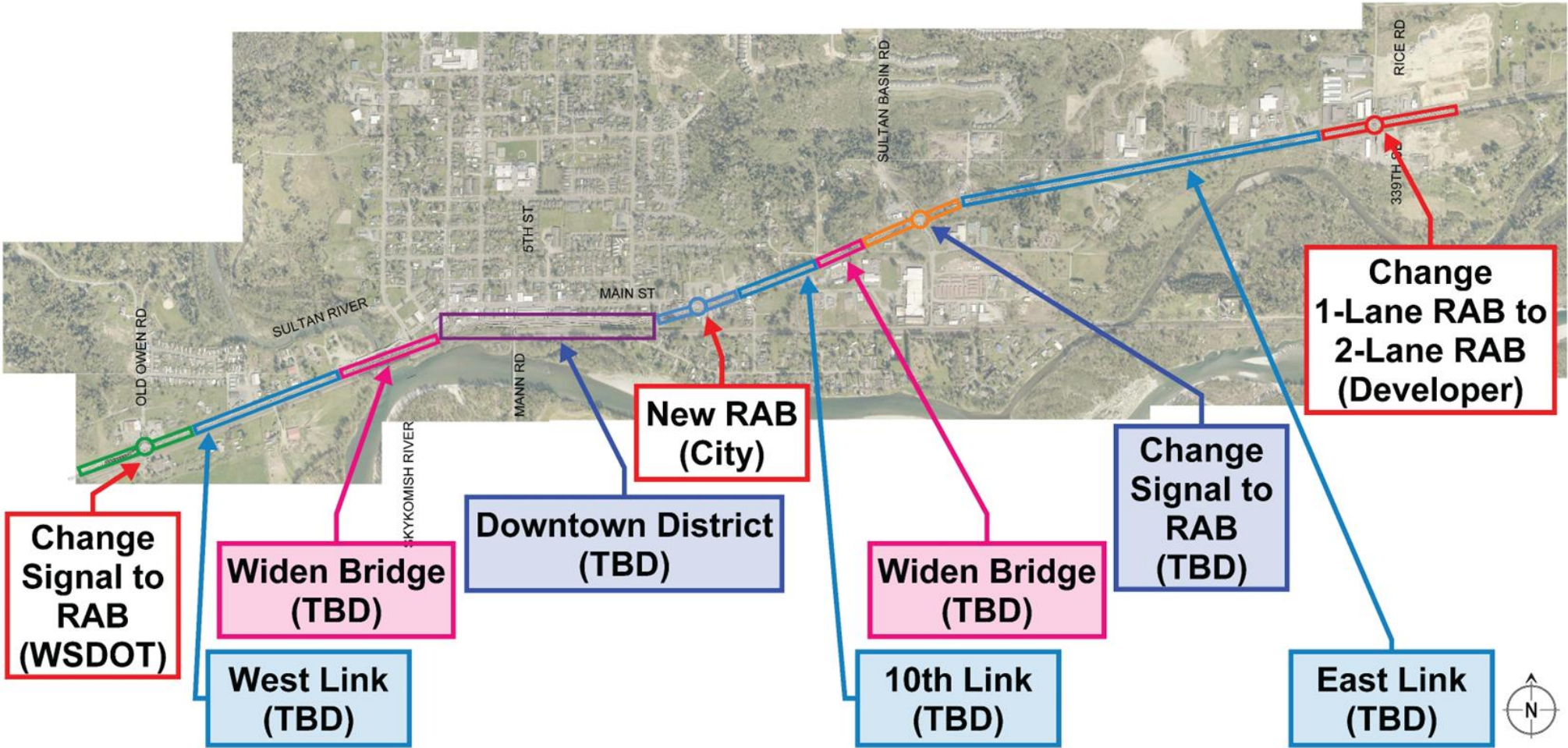


# Local and Regional Policy Support



- Consistent with WSDOT Long-Range Corridor Improvement Project
- Supports City of Sultan Growth Targets
- Improves safety and efficiencies for all users
- Provides multimodal access for all users

# Safety and Multimodal Benefits



- Identified in Sultan's 2020 Local Road Safety Plan as a Highest Priority US 2 Corridor Safety Improvement Project
- Roundabout increases safety over minor approach stop control for all users

## **Non-motorized Users**

- Provides opportunity to cross US-2 safely to access regional transit stops and local businesses.
- Provides Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) crossings to enhance pedestrian safety and ADA requirements

## **Motor Vehicles**

- Reduces vehicle/vehicle conflicts and speeds to reducing fatal and serious injury crashes over 75%
- Supports U-Turns for access management

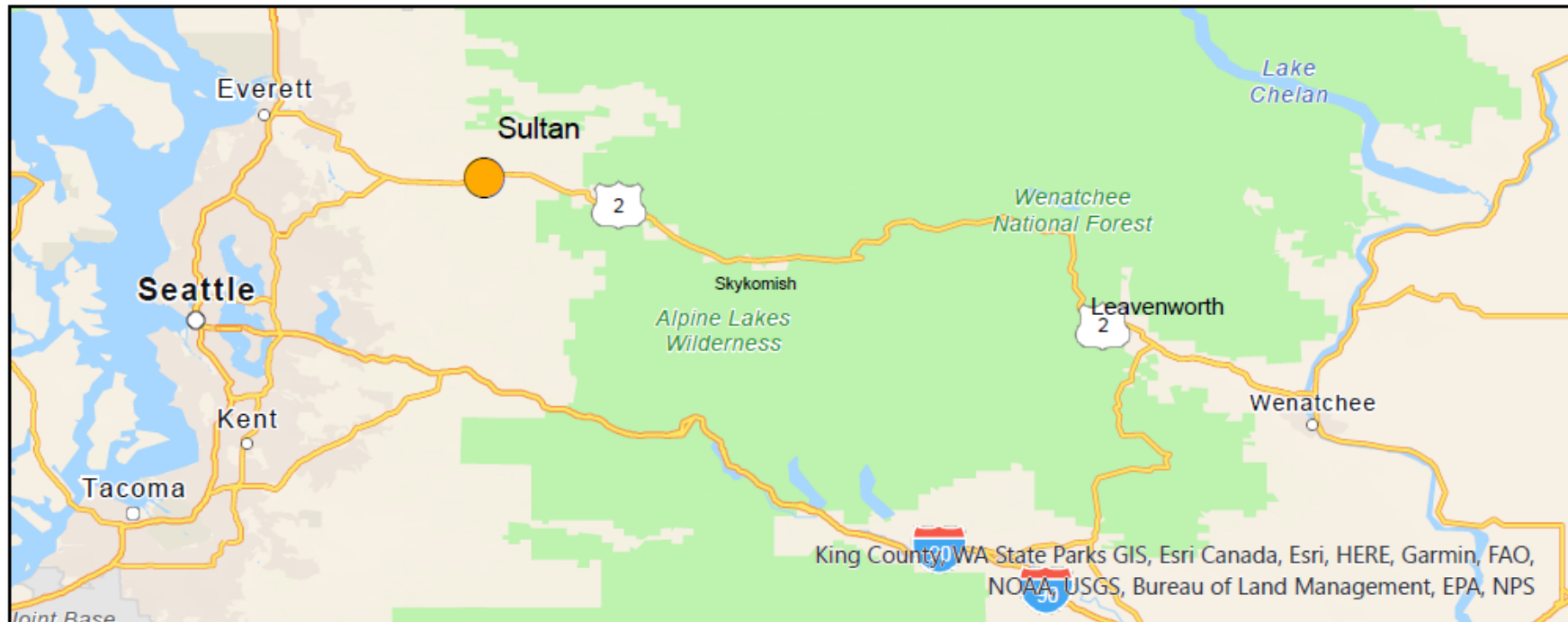


**Commute Trips:** Monroe, Everett, Seattle

**Recreational Trips:** Stevens Pass, Leavenworth

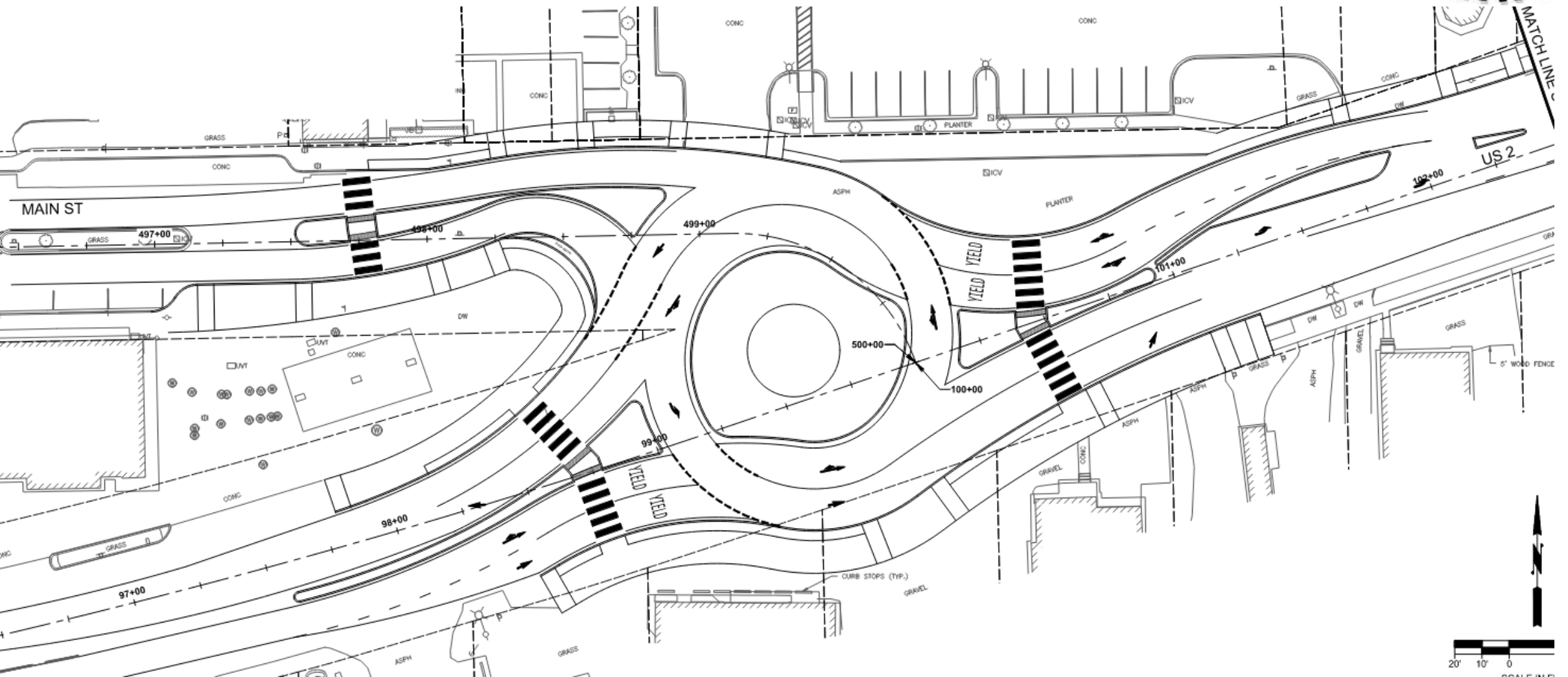
**Freight Mobility:** Everett/Seattle to Wenatchee/Spokane

# Currant Project Status

- 30% design complete
- Design Documents submitted to WSDOT



# Project Readiness



- US 2 public outreach campaign completed in 2022
- WSDOT Channelization Plan, ICE, Basis of design Submitted
- Local matching funds in hand; project is included in City's Transportation Impact Fee program, S.T.I.P and our local T.I.P
- Design completion planned for June 2024 **fully funded**
- Right of Way phase **fully funded** and planned to start in 2024
